Artist Agreement for "140hours GivesBack" Program

This Artist Agreement ("AA") for "140hours GivesBack" is between **140 Hours of Fame ("140HOF")**, located at 11 Phelps Place, Staten Island, NY 10301 USA, and _____, residing at _____ ("Artist"), and collectively ("the Parties"). This Agreement constitutes a complete, sole mutual agreement and contract between the Parties. Its terms become binding upon execution of their respective signatures hereon and upon the date noted.

INTRODUCTION

140 Hours of Fame® has pioneered a unique Internet-based online art auction event, "140 Hours of Fame®", which utilizes web technologies, including TWITTER™, to facilitate a real-time, global art auction. The "140 Hours of Fame®" concept, brand name and all related descriptions of it as supplied are the sole intellectual property of 140HOF. The event's official website, <http://140hours.com>, is owned and operated by 140HOF.

We have determined that it is in the best interests of our enterprise to pursue development of a new program, "140hours GivesBack", which will allow apportioning a small portion of each artist's sales to charitable organizations, primarily 501(c)(3)'s that are headquartered in the USA, in order to support the philanthropic work of these charities and to draw attention and world-wide support for our member artists.

We believe this direction and initiative are in keeping with our goals to promote our artists, to build a wider and more affluent body of collectors and patrons, and in general to be perceived in the marketplace as offering both high-quality artworks, and attaining a leadership position as an art auction house.

Therefore, today we are asking you to join our program launch, to be made effective as of 12.11.09 at the launch of our special pre-Christmas 92 hour auction event, **to contribute 10% of your sales to the charitable organizations that join in our program**, beginning with **Haven Hospice**, an end-of-life multi location facility in Northern Florida that cares for the gravely ill no matter what their financial condition, and a registered 501(c)(3) organization since 1979.

In the coming months, **with your help**, we will identify and add to our list of certified charities that will be the recipient of your giving during the year, and you will be receiving a tax benefit to the full extent possible for your tax filings each year.

Further, to make it easier and seamless for your own account, we will, on your behalf, take care of the contribution payment from each auction where you have a work that is sold. You will receive from us a complete accounting of all transactions, and the charities to which you donate will provide the necessary tax forms before tax time each year.

If you like, please ask us to increase your opening bid prices by 10% which will compensate somewhat for the increased fees that will be taken out of your gross sale proceeds.
